Our organization is one of the largest women's political committees in Santa Barbara County, with well over 300 members. The Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee supports H.R. 1236 as we are well informed about the many school shootings and other horrible massacres in which family members or law enforcement were aware of a potential threat yet were powerless to act under the law at the time. We understand that this proposed law is similar to recently enacted legislation in California as well as to a bill which was previously introduced by you in the last Congressional session.
