This bill addresses several critical reforms, such as moving sexual harassment prosecution decisions outside the chain of command, to an Office of the Chief Prosecutor within each military service and creating a confidential reporting process integrated with the Department of Defense's Catch a Serial Offender Database. It will also make sexual harassment a punishable crime under the Uniform Code of Military Justice. These changes will save lives by letting soldiers know that they are safe and they can come forward.
