We are aware that the Biden administration has already taken action to rescind the global gag rule for now, but Congress must pass the Global Health, Empowerment, and Rights (HER) Act to end the global gag rule for good. This rule targets international organizations that work on U.S.-funded health projects to expand access to contraception, prevent and treat HIV/AIDS, combat malaria, and improve maternal and child health. Under the global gag rule, groups are banned from all U.S. government global health funding if they provide, counsel, refer, or advocate for safe and legal abortion -- even with their own funding. The global gag rule is devastating for people who already face barriers to care around the world by cutting off access to many of the best, trusted health care providers, thus women and girls lifesaving health care services. And evidence shows that this restriction on programs that are meant to help people around the world is directly responsible for increased deaths from unsafe abortions and pregnancy complications.
