RE: AB 1261 - Immigration: unaccompanied and undocumented minors - SUPPORT

Dear Assemblymember Bonta:

On behalf of the Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee (SBWPC), we are writing to express support for AB 1261 addressing the right to legal counsel for unaccompanied and undocumented minors. SBWPC's mission is dedicated to furthering gender equality and other feminist values. We advocate for a diverse set of positions which include belief in and promotion of full and equal rights for all. Our position calls for policies that ensure that immigrant communities are free from harassment, intimidation, family separation, inhumane and/or unlawful detainment, and discrimination, as well as receiving equal protection and due process under the law. <a href="https://sbwpc.org/positions/">https://sbwpc.org/positions/</a>.

We support AB 1261's establishment of a right to legal counsel for unaccompanied minors residing in California who have been placed in immigration removal proceedings. This bill mandates the provision or appointment of legal counsel to all unaccompanied children in such proceedings, unless they have independently secured representation. While certain organizations provide pro-bono legal services to children, many minors still have to face these complex legal processes on their own.

The Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee regards AB 1261 as an important step forward in implementing fair, equitable, and compassionate immigration policies. **Therefore, SBWPC wishes to sign on as a supporter of AB 1261.**
